New in 2016

1) Cut-off age for the fall season is birth year as of 1/1/2016

2) Concussion Policy, educating coaches is key

The IYSA is now mandating that all leagues must follow the IYSA Concussion policy. All coaches carded to a team must complete the CDC tutorial before a coach's pass will be issued. The CIYSL Board of Directors has determined that it will be up to the individual Clubs and teams to monitor this qualification. In order to insure this compliance, all individual Clubs and teams must sign a 'Statement of Understanding' and return to the League office before any team passes are issued. This policy will be strictly enforced.

Very useful discussion. Board reviewed logistics and procedures

Post and communicate basic procedures to identify concussion symptoms. Include in all communications to families, coaches meeting, referee clinic

Referees, coaches and families are all responsible for the safety of the kids.

If concussion is eviendt, players must not be permitted to retain to game without physicians release

3) The heading ban -- how refs should respond

The U.S. Soccer Federation announced a ban on heading for players age 10 and younger. Last week, the U.S. Soccer Referee program sent out a memo on how the rule should be implemented:

"When a player deliberately heads the ball in a game, an indirect free kick (IFK) should be awarded to the opposing team from the spot of the offense. If the deliberate header occurs within the goal area, the indirect free kick should be taken on the goal area line parallel to the goal line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred. If a player does not deliberately head the ball, then play should continue."

All player U12 and under NO HEADERS POLICY in effect immediately
All trainers, coaches, field monitors and families to cease header practices
Policy will be communicated to families, coaches and referees
Deliberate headers will be penalized by awarding a direct kick to the opponent team
Include corner kicks, and all potential plays.
PK will be awarded if deliberate headers are exercised in the area
All coaches and players will be reminded with new policy at the beginning of each game
